b. PX services were not available to the Battalion due to physical location, however, a Division PX representative visited our forward position for the purpose of giving the personnel an opportunity to purchase cameras. A sufficient supply of SP rations were available for the necessary health and comfort items.

c. Postal Affairs are satisfactory. There is some delay in delivering mail when resupply helicopters are not flying due to adverse weather conditions. This command is utilizing the Unit #9 Post Office.

d. Liberty was not authorized during the period.

e. The R&R program continues to be a major morale factor within this command. There were 116 out-of-country and 14 in-country R&R quotas utilized during this reporting period.

S-2 CHRONOLOGY

1. SIGNIFICANT EVENTS. Between 1 and 3 December 1966, companies L&M with Command Group Alfa continued search and Destroy mission. Company I surprise and killed 5 NVA's and captured 1 NVA. Personnel were NV. Sniper Team with 2 Cadre. "M" Co. search and destroy operation commenced 9Dec66 ended 11Dec66, with 3 NVA KIA (Conf). Company L received mortar fire on 4Dec66. Lima and Mike Cos. received mortar fire on 20Dec66. On 28Dec66 3/3 Command Post and M Co. received mortar fire count estimated at 107 rounds. On 16Dec66 Co. K's ambush killed 5 NVA's and captured 4 AK-47s.
2. NEW DEVELOPMENTS. None
3. PROBLEM AREAS. AN/TPS-21 Ground Surveillance Radar had considerable down time due to weather conditions and lack of spare parts. Battalion has no Starlight Scopes and no seismic Intrusion Devices.
4. WEATHER. Weather in Battalion's AO has been monsoon with heavy rains during most of the early and middle parts of the month, clearing towards the end of the month. Weather had a great influence of the following activities during the month; resupply and Medevacs. Helicopters were hampered by poor visibility and heavy rains.
5. INTELLIGENCE SUMMARY. VC/NVA activity during the month of December increased in sightings and small unit actions. There were 17 VC/NVA initiated incidents during the month.
6. DAILY INTELLIGENCE SUMMARIES. Attached as appendix 1
7. SPECIAL INTELLIGENCE REPORTS. None
8. PRISONER REPORT. One NVA has been captured in the month of December.
9. ENEMY CASUALTIES.
 - a. There 21VC/NVA killed (Conf). 2 VC/NVA (Prof.) killed.
 - b. There were 3 VC/NVA MIA's Conf.
10. CAPTURED EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES. Captured weapons and equipment included 4 AK-47's, 6 rifles and 4 sniper scopes, 40 ChiCom grenades, 100 rounds of 50 cal. link ammo. 50 lbs. of rice was found and then destroyed as unfit. 3 82mm rounds and numerous web gear were also captured.
11. DES ROYER DE ENSES/POSITIONS. There were 4 caves, 4 bunkers, 2 mortar positions, 20 fighting holes and several punji pits destroyed this month.

S-3 CHRONOLOGY1. Significant Events.

1 December 1966. No significant events.

2 December 1966.

3 December 1966. At 030605H 3/3 Landing force at (YD 107507) located 6 NVA in hut eating breakfast. Fire fight resulted 5 enemy KIA (Conf) and 1 NVA captured. Captured 3 rifles with sniper scopes, 2 auto carbines, US rifle M1, 2 Chicom grenades, 60 rds for sniper rifles, 250 rds for auto-rifle, 48 rds for M1, 1 pair field glasses, 4 packs, 3 improvised parcels, 5 canteens, misc blankets, hammocks, cotton uniforms, civilian clothing, rifle cleaning gear, first aid kit, 7 lbs rice, 1 wallet containing approx \$20,000 piastres, and map case containing misc papers and documents. Captured material will be forwarded to G-2. Results of action 5 KIA (Conf) and 1 NVA captured.

At 031000H M/3/3 at (YD 103510) located grave containing one body in NVA uniform estimated 3 to 4 days old and died of stomach wound from S/A. 1 KIA (Prob) of 300920H changed to 1 KIA (conf).

At 031047H commenced helo lift of Qnd Grp, Co I and M from Cua Valley to Rockpile.

At 031150H completed helo lift of F/2/9 from the Rockpile to Camp Carroll, and return OPCON to 2/3 at 031150H.

At 031330H Helo lift of Qnd Group and Co I and M from Cua Valley to Rock File completed.

Reference my SitRep No# 189 030605H. Co I/3/3 debriefing of Plt disclosed that 1 NVA escaped out the back of the hut. Search of area indicated that the NVA was wounded. By location of Blood trail.

4 December 1966. At 041515H L/3/3/ at (XD 974568) received A/W fire in CP from (XD 967567). H 37A in L/3/3 LZ received 26 hits from S/A and shrapnel prior to and during fly away. Engine failure forced landing at Camp Carroll LZ. A Co 3d Tanks in L/3/3 CP received 4 rds possible 75mm rocket fire resulting in heavy damage. L/3/3 and tanks, tanks and 81mm mortar return fire. Observed 1 enemy hit by multiple rounds. Unable to recover body at present time. Plt (-) searched area until dark. Will continue operation in same area at 050630H. Casualties 1 USMC WIA; 6 L/3/3 (Minor), 1 helo crewman (Minor), 1 helopilot (MedEvac) and 1 enemy KIA (Conf).

At 041730H L/3/3/ at (XD 978584) received 81mm mortar short round landing fire mission resulting in 6 USMC WIA (Minor).

At 041835H K/3/3 at (XD 988589) platoon enroute to ambush site received S/A fire. Platoon returned S/A fire and called 81mm mortars and arty fire mission with good target coverage. 1 USMC KIA, 2 USMC WIA.

At 042035H M/3/3 observed lights at (XD 968575). Arty fire mission with good target coverage. Results unknown.

ENCLOSURE (3)

5 December 1966. At 050145H 3/3 at (XD 981582) had emergency Med Evac of 1 USMC KIA and 3 USMC WIA previously reported.

At 051100H (Late entry) at (XD 983565) CH-46 departing 3/3 LZ commencing firing at the Razor Back vic (XD 967565) indicating that they received fire. 3/3 personnel in LZ stated they heard no fire except from helo. ordered helo to cease fire due to friendly troops in area.

6 December 1966. Non-battle casualties. I/3/3 MedEvac 1 USMC due to convulsions.

7 December 1966. At 070900H M/3/3 departed CP by foot march. One point along route #1 (YD 964587), #2 (YD 9659) and #3 (YD 951586).

8 December 1966. At 081200H M/3/3 had 2 MedEvac 1 USMC burns on leg and hand. 1 USMC relapse malaria.

At 081515H M/3/3 observed 1 VC wearing dark clothing running from (XD 947595) toward SW. Arty fire mission called. Excellent target coverage.

At 081530H M/3/3 located 4 bunkers, 2 were destroyed prior to discovery. remaining 2 contained, chairs, tables, bunks and empty food containers. Bunkers were destroyed.

At 081945H K/3/3 observed 3 lights at (XD 977583). 81mm mortars fired mission on target and lights were extinguished.

At 082030H L/3/3 observed lights at (XD 969570) 81mm mortars and 106 RH fired mission at target. Lights were extinguished.

9 December 1966. At 090830H M/3/3 received S/A fire from est squad in area at (XD 954587). Returned S/A fire. Results of action 1 USMC KIA and 1 USMC WIA.

At 091540H M/3/3 received S/A fire from (XD 952592) returned S/A fire called arty fire mission on target. Results of action 9 USMC WIA.

At 091330H K/3/3 observed 3 VC in dark clothing about 600 meters from platoon (XD 989598). 81mm mortars fire mission called and enemy fled east into wooded area. Results unknown.

At 091430H I/3/3 located rusty explosive device at (XD 981589) approx 50 lbs 4 1/2 ft long and 10 1/2 to 11 inches in width. Marked area and notified.

At 091540H 3/3 OP on Rock Pile observed NVA on ridge (XD 970614). Arty fire mission called with good target coverage. Results unknown.

At 091630H 3/3 OP on Rock Pile observed 10 NVA on ridge at (XD 970614) 2 NVA on ridge at (XD 988611); K/3/3 observed troops in open at (XD 967617) arty fire mission called with good target coverage. Results unknown.

At 092000H M/3/3 (XD 953583) moving to (XD 948582) Movement slow to WIA's.

ENCLOSURE (3)

10 December 1966. At 101245H M/3/3 at (XD 958592) received 2 250 lb bombs which apparently missed target area and went long over ridge landing in M/3/3 PSN, resulting in 17 USMC KIA and 11 USMC WIA.

At 101438H Med Evac of M/3/3 casualties completed.

At 101615H K/3/3 plt received short 81mm mortar round (WP) at (XD 991589) reported 200 meters short of target. Resulted in 1 USMC WIA. Med Evac completed at 102230H.

At 102045H I/3/3 observed lights at (XD 97861C). Arty fire mission called, good target coverage, light extinguished.

At 102205H M/3/3 at (XD 969593) continues movement to CP at (XD 978589).

11 December 1966. At 110229H M/3/3 arrived at CP (XD 978589).

At 112040H 3/3 OP on Rock Pile received S/A fire. 81mm mortars and illum fired. 112130H enemy fired ceased W/O USMC casualties.

At 112240H 3/3 OP on Rock Pile observed lights approx 100 meters below to the NW. Fired M-79. Light extinguished. Will search area at first light.

12 December 1966. At 120010H 3/3 OP on Rock Pile (XD 979559) received S/A fire. Returned S/A fire and called Arty illum fire mission.

At 120100H Rock Pile OP (XD 979559) reports firing has stopped and started again at 120105H. Area to be searched at first light.

At 120130H Rock Pile OP (XD 979559) reports having fired at movement approximately 30 meters SE of position. Firing commenced at 120103H and ended at 120110H.

At 121930 Patrol found enemy base camp and 3 mortar pits with punji stakes. Used around last 48 hours. Destroyed by patrol.

At 122035H. M/3/3 FO saw lights on Mitters Ridge. Arty fire mission called. Lights went out, results unknown.

13 December 1966. At 0100H L/3/3 received schrapnel from last barrage between Razor Back and lines. No friendly injuries.

At 1420H M3/3 FO spotted 3 VC at (955588) 81mm mortars fire mission called, good target coverage, results unknown.

At 2130H man in IA 1 has accidental discharge while moving into ambush.

At 2310H Arty round impacted within 100 meters of Co I LP.

14 December 1966. At 140500H Arty round impacted vic (992578) within 50 meters of Co I ambush. H&I's mission cancelled. Btry "C" will check area. analysis to be held to determine possibility of enemy fire.

At 141600H commence operation on Razor Back Ridge in accordance with Order 13-66. Execute Frag Order 13-66. H-Hour 150800H.

15 December 1966. At 151020 MP 2 sighted two bunkers at 150950H at (XD 992578). 81mm mortar fire mission called, Good target coverage. Results unknown.

ENCLOSURE (3)

16 December 1966. At 160725H a trip flare was set off at (982590) in front of OP. KA 2 engaged enemy moving toward them, KA 2 engaged enemy resulting in 5 enemy KIA. , and 4 weapons captured.

161155H KA 2 return to Bn CP with enemy bodies and equipment. All equipment and documents will be turn over to Crowd 2.

161450H H&S Co 3/3 man had accidental discharge wounding himself in left abdomen with 45 pistol. Med Evac to base at 161600H .

17 December 1966. At 171230H suspected enemy movement on ridge at (984613) Arty fire mission called. Excellent target coverage, movement ceased.

At 171917H Co M spotted 5 enemy at (985587) at 171800H. Fire mission called good target coverage, results unknown.

18 December 1966. At 180310H bombs landed in vic (990608) to (975600). Cuts and eye irritation evident at this position.

At 181120H Cancelled all air strikes in Payable area due to Payable AIO being absence at this time.

At 181245H during initial pass of strike air craft. Personnel of Co J at (964572) reported hearing what they believed to be S/A fire. Area checked by AO, neg. results.

At 181640H during normal resupply members of LP1 reported hearing S/A firing from the SW at an estimated distance of 1500-2000 meters. Sound very faint. No rds were observed striking in the LZ or within the area. Altho no rds were observed falling in the area the Plt Omdr felt it was desirable to have the helo depart area to be on the safe side.

19 December 1966. At 191050 FO Co M observed six enemy on Razor Back at (958588) . 81mm mortar mission called. Excellent target coverage, results unknown.

At 191515H Lima Flt located on Razor Back. Observed 5 VC wearing mixed articles of clothing (civilian) and carrying packs and rifles. Sniper teams attached to Co L killed one and wounded one.

At 191835H Engineers picked up at Rock File, had to leave 160 lbs demo. Request demo be sent this position.

At 191900H During the TFQ-10 strike at above time and at (958598). A small white air burst estimated 20 to 30 meters in air, at about 6000-7000 feet went off behind the air craft.

20 December 1966. At 201100 Co M FO reported 5 VC in open at (988608) Arty fire mission called with good target coverage, also sighted bunker at (988608). 106RR fire mission called, target destroyed. Arty fire mission called with good target coverage.

At 201440 MP1 found 6 freshly dug graves. MP1 opened the graves and found bodies estimated 3 days old by corpsman. Bodies were badly mutilated as though they had been hit by 81mm or Arty fire. Bodies wrapped in ponchoes. enemy confirmed.

20 December 1966. At 201500 MP1 found sleeping area for about 50 people, 20 fighting holes, 9 with covers. Area destroyed.

At 202010 Co Lima began receiving mortar fire at their CP. 5 to 10 minutes later mortar fire was received by Co Mike. Fire remain in Co M area and none received in Bn CP area. Co L reported receiving S/A fire also. Immediate counter mortar fire mission called by Co L at (965565). Co M called counter mortar mission at (963583). S/A and A/W fire was being received by Co L from (966565) and was returned. Arty fire mission called at both suspected enemy positions, Tams and Unos fired at Razor Back at movement on Razor Back, vic (967567). Arty fire mission registered for fire box west of Razor Back. Flare ship requested for use at 2100. Maximum use of Arty planned vic west and north this CP. Ambush position for 100 moved to new position at (995509). Max Evac requested. Fire mission called with excellent target coverage incoming fire suppressed by 201940. 81mm mortars registered around LP1 on Razor Back and maximum use of Arty planned for areawest of Razor Back. Excellent target coverage by supporting arms. Flare ship on station by 2000 with excellent support given. All scheduled night activities to proceed as normal.

21 December 1966. It is estimated between 40-50 rounds of mixed 81mm and 60mm mortars impacted Co Lima position. Material forwarded to 3d Marines CP.

At 211415H. Co Mike FO observed 23 enemy at (966616) Arty mission requested. Mission to be controlled by recon in area.

At 211700H. Co Kilo FO reported seeing 3 VC walking at (985610) at 211700. Arty fired, excellent target coverage, results unknown.

At 212100H. Co Mike spotted lights vic (958613). Arty fire mission called with excellent target coverage. Lights extinguished.

At 212115H. Rock Pile OP reports receiving 2 rds S/A fire at (980558). Return with S/A and grenades. Incoming stopped.

22 December 1966. At 221225 MP 3 found a 250 lb bomb located at (978595) at 221225. EOD team requested.

23 December 1966. No significant events.

24 December 1966. At 240700 truce in effect. Maintain alert.

25 December 1966. At 251240 LP 1 reports seeing approx 20 civilian moving along Hy#9 going south west.

26 December 1966. No Significant events.

27 December 1966. No Significant events.

Immediate counter mortar fire return at suspected enemy positions at (992607), (997603) and (987607). Arty fire mission called at above coord., and at (969575). Fire mission was checked for 2/3 Med Evac and now continues. Med Evac requested for casualties at this CP and at KP 2. Co India spotted flashes at (989580) and received incoming at same time. Co India returned fire at flashes with 60mm mortar. Major equipment losses are: 30600 knocked out with round in chamber. Two radio relay generators. Two bottles lost from direct hit. Med Evac completed for 1 KIA and 12 WIA's.

At 282038 KP 2 did not receive Med Evac and continues movement to units of with 1 KIA and 10 WIA's. Co Kilo ammo dump received hit and has three smoking WP rounds in dump. All incoming ceased at 281800 for this CP area. Casualties for KP 2 to be reported to this CP for treatment at 0800 and to await earliest Med Evac. Co Kilo ammo dump revetted and surrounding area evacuated. Fire in dump out. Total incoming rds counted were 107 with 5 duds located. Crater analysis to follow at first light. Good target coverage reported for 81mm and Arty fire mission.

At 281730 at (969575) LP 3 spotted 3 enemy at above coord and time. Four mortars fire called with good target coverage, results unknown. Area to be searched at first light.

29 December 1966. At 290620 KP 2 returned to this CP with casualties. Casualties at BAS reported in shock. Six emergency. Med Evac requested. Total Med Evac 1 KIA and 10 WIA's.

At 290735 all casualties Med Evac.

At 291310 crater analysis reveals the following information: All craters on Razor Back azm. of approx 6100 mils from (981583) and were of approx 81mm/82mm size. One crater approx 5 ft deep and 7 inches in dia. Believed to be dud.

At 291700 new crater located at (981582). Believed to be larger dud. 81mm/82mm mortar.

At 291721 Scouts attached to Co M spotted 2 VC on Razor Back at (969575). 57RR fire mission called. Direct hit 2 VC KIA.

At 291845 Scouts attached to Co M spotted 4 VC on Razor Back at (969575). Arty mortar mission called. Good target coverage, results unknown.

30 December 1966. At 300530 L/3/3 reported P-5003 while moving back from head was challenged by two Marines. He did not answer challenge and was shot by Marine with M-14. P-5003 received minor wound and was Med Evac.

At 301530 resupply helo crashed while lifting from Razor Back LZ at (969575).

At 301730 Recon unit (Habu) chop OPCON to 3/3 and will remain in PL until tonight.

31 December 1966. No significant events.
