S-2 Chronology

~~1. Significant Events.~~

A. On 12 Jan 1967 3d Battalion, 3d Marines displaced Companies I, M, H&S and the Battalion C.P. from the vicinity of AD979583, to the vicinity of AD986550. The Battalion Area of operations was enlarged at this time to include the Ca Lu outpost and part of the Ba Long Valley.

B. The most significant enemy contact during the month was the capture of a V.C. hamlet guerilla one Thai Viet HAN from Dien Dien hamlet, in the Ba Long Valley, on 12 Jan 1967. Interrogation by 15th CIT produced that there were 15 V.V. guerillas and 7 V.C. cadre living in the hamlet. Acting on this intelligence, Battalion Command Group "A" with Cos. I and K conducted a search and destroy operation of Dien Dien Hamlet. Co. I on 29 Jan 67 killed 2 V.C. captured 9 confirmed V.C., along with 11 ChiCom Carbines, 1 Thompson 45 cal. Sub-machine Gun, 1 French 9mm Sub-machine gun, 16 ChiCom grenades, 800lbs. of rice, a small amount of medical supplies and equipment, assorted uniforms, NVA Sneakers and 400 rounds small arms ammunition.

2. New Developments. EOD retrieved a dud mortar round, which proved to be a 120mm. This round was received during the 26 Dec 66 mortar attack against this Battalion.

3. Problem Areas. The AN/TPS 21 continued to remain the biggest operational problem, both sets have been in FLSU maintenance during the complete month of January. The lack of any AN/P2S-1 in the Battalion has prevented the employment of this device.

4. Weather. The weather during the month of January has been rainy and cloudy with temperatures averaging in the 70's. The mean high for the month was 88 the low was 53. The monsoon rains have not deterred operational effectiveness during this period.

5. Intelligence Summary. During the month of January the number of mortar attacks decreased from December, 2 during January, 3 during December. The number of enemy initiated incidents during January were 15 compared to 22 during the previous month.

7. Special Intelligence Reports. None.

8. Prisoner Report. During the month of January 13 V.C. prisoners were taken. This is an increase of 12 over the previous month.

S-3 CHRONOLOGY1. Significant Events.

1 January 1967. At 010805H Habu remains under 3d Battalion, 3d Marines OPCON based upon Commanding Officer's recommendation. Habu's original mission has been cancelled.

2 January 1967. At 021115H at (976582) Mike patrol found cave 9 feet wide, 3 feet high and 5 feet deep, estimated 1 week old. Destroyed by demo.

3 January 1967. At 031140H Mike Co FO spotted 2 enemy at (962584). Immediately engaged with 106RR and called Arty mission. Excellent target coverage. Results unknown.

At 03:335 Pluto entered Lima Co CP. Pluto notified that they are under OPCON of 3d Battalion, 3d Marines.

4 January 1967. At 041035H coord (973574) Mike Co FO observed 4 enemy. 106RR immediately engaged enemy. 81mm mortars fire mission called with good target coverage. Results unknown.

At 041650H India Company patrol found cave at (991579). Cave was destroyed.

At 041730H 81mm round fell short in another gun pit. Received Med Evac helo lifted out at 041755.

5 January 1967. No significant events.

6 January 1967. No significant events.

7 January 1967. At 071305H BOD personnel at 3/3 CP completed removal of round received during last mortar attack on 3/3 area on 28 December 1966. Round is 120mm mortar. Round is in possession of BOD team.

8 January 1967. At 081200 coord (977569) Company Mike observed one enemy wearing light brown uniform moving west to east. Snipers took enemy under fire, enemy disappear into the wood line.

At 081230 at coord (968588) Company Mike patrol was checking area at above coord when they received 40 rounds of A/W fire. Company Mike patrol returned the fire and then checked area out with negative results

9 January 1967. At 090015H coord (976684) Company Mike LP observed three enemy moving in an undetermined direction, one enemy was carrying what appeared to be a rifle. 60mm mortar fire mission called. Good target coverage, results unknown.

At 090500H coord (982585) 3d Platoon Company Mike observed movement of five enemy who has set off three trip flares. M-79's was fired at the enemy. Results unknown.

ENCLOSURE (3)

10 January 1967. At 101045H vic (966578). Company Mike FO observed three enemy standing in treeline, equipment and clothing unknown. Arty mission called followed by 106RR direct fire. Good target coverage, results unknown.

At 101855 vic (967567) 2nd platoon Company Lima observed three enemy in dark clothing. Enemy fired approximately 40 rounds of small arms at Lima platoon. Lima platoon returned fire with small arms fire and called in 106RR direct fire, excellent target coverage. Platoon searched area and found head of one enemy, portion of uniform gray green in color.

11 January 1967. At 111600H vic (968569) Lima patrol came under heavy small arms fire from vic (963569). Patrol returned fire with small arms and they suffered one WIA Med Evac not required. At approximately the same time Co Mike and 3/3 CP came under mortar fire estimated 50 rounds of 82mm Mortar. Arty, tanks and 81mm mortars returned fire with excellent target coverage, results unknown. All action ceased at approximately 1630. Company Mike took two casualties, one WIA and one sprain back, Med Evac completed at 1725.

At 111740 vic (980589) Company Mike patrol discovered a 250 pound bomb and a 500 pound GP bomb with a string attached to a tree. The first bomb had the fins blown off and the second bomb was intact. EOD Team notified.

12 January 1967. At 121000H displacement commenced CH 46's moving supplies to Company Lima CP.

At 121220 3/3 CP and Company M previously occupied position received approximately 87 rounds of 82mm mortar rounds. Majority on Company Mike old position and 6 fell on 3/3 CP. Counter mortar fire plan executed. Excellent reaction time for 81mm mortars and Arty. Enemy wounds came from vicinity of (974576) and (993603). Both areas well covered by both 81mm mortar and arty fire.

13 January 1967. At 131820H Displacement completed for 3d Battalion, 3d Marines to new TAOR.

14 January 1967. At 141015H Company Lima received five rounds of small arms fire. Fire was received from base of Rock Pile. Area searched with negative results.

At 141630H vicinity of (961582) Company Lima FO observed three enemy at above time and coordinates. Artillery mission called with good target coverage, results unknown.

15 January 1967. No significant events.

ENCLOSURE (3)

16 January 1967. At 161355H vicinity (967571) Company Lima observed two enemy at above time and coordinates. Tanks and Ontos fire mission called with excellent target coverage. Results unknown.

At 161400H coordinates (985554) OP 62 observed two or three rounds fired on convoy with negative results.

At 161500H coordinates (965563) Company Lima patrol found one bag of vegetables along trail route.

At 161530H coordinates (960562) Company Lima sighted two enemy moving from south to north. Uniforms were gray or dark in color. Each was carrying a rifle type unknown. 81mm mortar fire mission called. Mission was cleared and reaction time was instantaneous. Excellent target coverage. results unknown.

At 161330H coordinates (002555) Company Mike patrol received two rounds of small arms fire. Rounds were fired from the east at a distance of about 60 meters. Small arms rounds were returned, area searched with negative results.

At 161540H coordinates (985535) Company Mike patrol while going through heavy terrain had a rifle accidentally discharge wounding one Marine. Marine suffered gun shot wound in left shoulder. Marine was able to walk to Battalion Aid Station.

17 January 1967. At 171145H coordinates (980530) Marine in Company Mike patrol cut himself with machete while cutting path through underbrush. Marine was picked up by Battalion Aid Station ambulance and patrol continued with mission.

18 January 1967. At 182110H coordinates (0347) and (0247) lights were observed by Company Kilo. Artillery mission called with excellent target coverage. Results unknown.

19 January 1967. No Significant Events.

20 January 1967. No Significant Events.

21 January 1967. At 211755H coordinates (961581). Company Lima spotted two enemy at above time and coordinates. No weapons were sighted, enemy were wearing gray uniforms. Artillery mission called with excellent target coverage, results unknown.

22 January 1967. No Significant Events.

23 January 1967. No Significant Events.

24 January 1967. No significant events.

25 January 1967. At 251650H coordinates (968562) Company Lima patrol found one chicom grenade, empty 50 cal ammo can, grenade holder and length of comm wire. All items listed above were destroyed.

26 January 1967. At 261100H coordinates (981531) Company India security conducting search of indigenous personnel found one male with PRC-25 battery.

27 January 1967. No significant events.

28 January 1967. At 280400H Company Mike returned to 3d Battalion, 3d Marines CP.

At 281735H coordinates (958577). Company Lima patrol observed four enemy. Two with weapons (type unknown) and one with helmet. All wearing dark clothing and moving slowly N.W. 81mm mortar fire mission called with excellent target coverage, results unknown.

29 January 1967. At 290200H 3d Battalion, 3d Marines conducted a search and clear operation in the Ba Long Valley from vicinity of Ca Lu coordinates (011454) to vicinity of coordinates (050440). Company Kilo (-) reinforced with one platoon of RF from 123rd RF Company and one Platoon of Company India jumped off from Company Kilo CP. Commenced search and clear operation at 290725H. 3d Battalion, 3d Marines Command Group and Company India linked with Company Kilo at 290850H. All villages within objective area were systematically searched for enemy personnel or equipment. Results of operation. Two enemy killed, eight prisoners, 12 rifles, 400 rounds, 15 chicom grenades and one 45 cal grease gun and French sub machine gun with full magazine captured. Assorted items of military and non military equipment also captured. Operation secured at 291850 when last elements of Command Group and Company India returned to 3d Battalion, 3d Marines CP. Company Kilo returned to their CP at 291830H.

30 January 1967. At 300725H coordinates (989441). A civilian reported to Company Kilo that a VC unit destroyed a bridge at above coordinates. Company Kilo checked area out, bridge was destroyed in last 24 hours.

At 301805 coordinates (957573) and (963572). Company Lima platoon on Razor Back came under heavy small arms fire at above time from above coordinates. Company Lima returned small arms fire and called 81mm mortar and artillery fire mission on above coordinates. Excellent target coverage, results unknown. Company Lima had three MIA's. Med Evac not requested.

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ENCLOSURE (3)

30 January 1967. At 301830H coordinates (025455) Company Kilo patrol apprehended VCS at above time and coordinates. Upon returning to CP VCS admitted having cached weapons within last ten days in vicinity of coordinates (046433).

At 300930H coordinates (983567). Company Lima patrol made contact with two enemy at above time and coordinates. Enemy dressed in khaki uniforms, carrying rifles type unknown. Patrol fired on enemy and lost contact. Searched area with negative results.

At 302050H coordinates (983533). Bridge security observed three persons moving west to east in front of wire. Could not observed type of clothing or equipment. Security fired small arms and threw grenades. Area searched with negative results.

At 302120H coordinates (981544). Bridge security received seven rounds of small arm fire from south going over top of bridge. 81mm mortars illuminated area, bridge security could not observe any movement.

31 January 1967. At 310400H Co K commenced operation in accordance with Frag Order 3-67.

At 310700H coordinates (040444) Co Kilo moved into hamlet held brief but complete search. Search found 2 admitted VC and 2 VCS.

At 310815H coordinates (964565) Company Lima patrol observed two men in green utilities. Searched area with negative results.

At 310400 Co Kilo (-) reinforced with a squad of RP jumped off Co CP. Arrived objective area 310645H. Search of hamlet resulted in the captured of 2 VCC and 2 VCS. VCS were released when it was determined that they were parents of VC and had not seen their children in over two months.

At 311130H Co Kilo returned to CP.

b. Company Lima.

(1) Maintain present position; continue normal operations; provide two rifle squads (Rein) for LZ security vicinity of coordinates (984544) at 120800H until relieved by elements of Company India.

c. Company India.

(1) Prepare for helilift 120900H, land in LZ; relieve Company Lima of LZ security; expand LZ; to include outposting of prominent terrain features to the North of LZ.

d. H&S Company.

(1) Land after Company India; establish battalion CP as directed.

e. Company Mike.

(1) Provide LZ security in present position; land after H&S Company and assume responsibility for that position of the battalion defensive perimeter as assigned.

f. Coordinating Instructions.

(1) D-Day 12 Jan67.

(2) H-Hour 0900H.

The following is a report of the results of Silicone foot ointment that was issued to this battalion on a trial basis: The ointment was distributed to all companies and instructions for proper application given. It was used on various small patrols with various degrees of success. By far the most comprehensive use and evaluation was on a sweep by Mike company. The following report was submitted by the Senior Corpserman of that company.
- (a) Experiment was conducted on operations from 25 - 27 January 1967. One hundred and seventy tubes were passed out the night before leaving, with about one hundred and fifty having time to apply the ointment. The first days march was about 1500 meters up several hills with about one hundred feet elevation. The second day was a 17 hour march of about 15,000 meters.

Approximately 8000 meters were up a river with all feet immersed for about eight hours. There followed approximately a 4000 meter walk over rocks, the remainder through dry rice paddies. On returning to the battalion area it was found that all personnel using product had, to some degree, stone bruises with a few blisters and one case of burning feet in which the patient had been treated previously. (b) The product seemed to prevent blisters, softening callouses and after seventeen hours of marching with wet feet there was no wrinkling nor cases of immersion foot.

(c) Reaction to the product was excellent with all personnel requesting more. Only complaints were of the stickiness and difficulty applying product. Socks were not affected but held soil to feet making it difficult to wash them out.
